

SCC Youth Summer Internship

Position: Summer Interns for youth ministry.

Hours and Dates: 10 hours a week – 7 weeks, July– Aug

Pay: \$10 an hour: \$500 for weekly ministry and \$100 for each camp attended
Total amount possible for the Summer: \$700

Reports: Summer Interns report to the Associate Pastor for Youth Ministries

Purpose:

- 1) To provide more openings for relational and discipleship ministries during the summer, increasing our opportunities to “encounter” and “educate.”
- 2) Taking someone who has graduated from our program, and putting them in a place where they can now pass on what they have learned and experienced will further our cause to “equip” our young people to be fully devoted followers of Christ.
- 3) This will give the Associate Pastor for Youth Ministries an avenue for mentoring and discipleship with graduating/graduated students who might be called into the ministry.

Job Description

1. Meet weekly with Youth Pastor for *planning, prayer, and discipleship* (which will include a weekly study on the topic of leadership and/or ministry).
2. Main responsibility is to assist Associate Pastor for Youth during the summer.
3. Will make contact with graduating 5th graders/incoming 6th graders and provide an opportunity for positive transition
3. Will assist with middle school/Edge weekly events
4. Will be responsible to lead and teach middle school Dgroup on Sunday morning
5. Will be involved in weekly relational ministry to junior high students
(Budget for expenses will be given).
6. Will be a leader for at least one, possibly both, Middle and High school summer camps.

Requirements:

1. High School Graduate.
2. Must go through interview with Associate Pastor for Youth
3. Must sign Leadership Covenant which includes a permission for background check
4. Must be a Christian and love youth.
5. Approval by Associate Pastor for Youth and Youth Committee

Middle School - The Edge

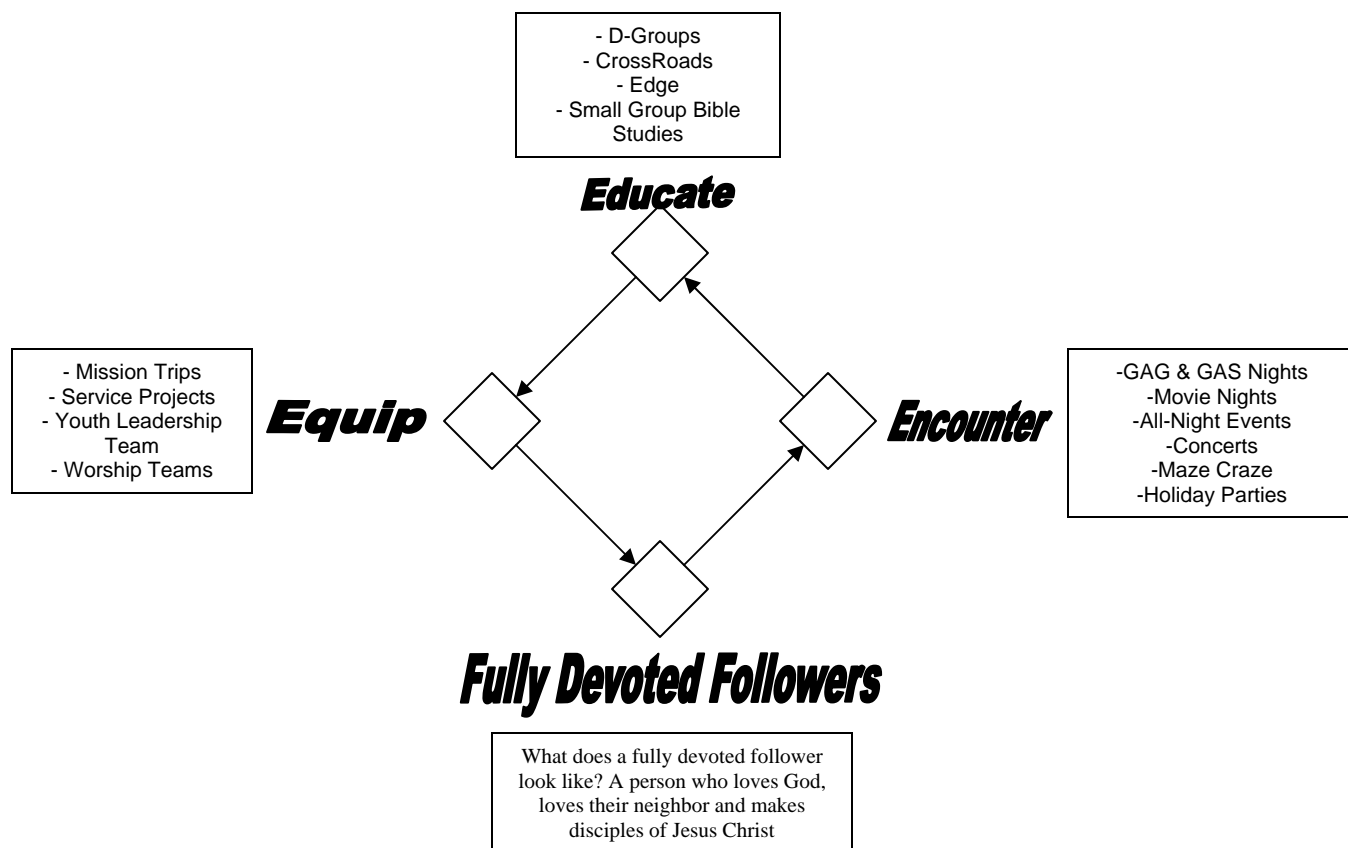
Wednesday Night 6:30-8:00pm

Leadership Covenant

- 1) I understand that to be a leader I must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior. I believe that only through Jesus Christ is there salvation and eternal life.
- 2) I understand that the Bible is the inspired word of God, without error in all matters of faith and practice. They are the foundation and final authority in our ministry.
- 3) I understand that my life is going to be an example to others and therefore must be wise in the areas of drinking, sexuality, dating/marriage, how I act & what I say.
- 4) I understand that as a high school leader, I will not date high school or middle school students, and as a middle school leader I will not date middle school students.
- 5) I understand that I am expected to be at leadership on time for prayer and unity building and to stay a little longer after program to invest in students and help clean up. If I will not be attending, I will let the Youth Pastor know in advance so he/she may plan accordingly.
- 6) I understand that I can not spiritually feed unless I am being fed first. I will make sure that leadership is not the place that I get fed spiritually but will at least go to one other meeting for my own growth either on Sunday Morning, a small group, or another program.
- 7) I understand that if I drive students that I will have parent permission first and that I will not drive in a dangerous manner, respecting the fact that their lives depend on my actions. I will not drive alone with students of the opposite sex in my vehicle unless OK'd by both the parents and youth pastor.
- 8) I understand that if I have a problem with another leader that I will first approach that leader instead of discussing it with others. I want to promote the unity and success of our ministry. I will respect and love the other leaders even if I don't like them very much.
- 9) I understand the purpose of our youth program is in response to the great commandments and the great commission. That we exist to Invite and Disciple students to be fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ. We accomplish this by providing programs to "encounter" "educate" and "equip" the students in our community.
- 10) I understand that if I have been convicted of a criminal offense or involved in any kind of child or sexual abuse that I must share that with the youth pastor. I am giving permission with my signature on this covenant for SCC to check my record and do a background check.
